In terms of the order dated 8th March, 2022, the B.L. & L.R.O., Hingalgunj, gave notice to the petitioner for the purpose of demarcation. The petitioner has not yet received any such report from the B.L. & L.R.O.

In those circumstances, the respondent no. 4/Executive Engineer (Roads), P.W.D., Basirhat Sub-Division shall supply a copy of this report to the petitioner, after demarcation, and within a period of one month from the date of communication of a copy of this order.

Based on the report of the PWD, appropriate action under the West Bengal Highways Act, 1962, may be initiated by the respondent no. 4. The petitioner is at liberty to take steps in that direction, and in that regard, if necessary.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.
