Case No.435 of 2022** dated **01/08/2022** under Sections **498A/307** of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections **3/4** of Dowry Prohibition Act. (corresponding to G.R. Case No.1289/2022).

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

The Court is informed that the husband was granted anticipatory bail by the High Court.

State is represented.

The police complaint was lodged after nine years of marriage.

Considering the materials in the case diary and considering the fact that the husband was enlarged on anticipatory bail by the order dated September 8, 2022 passed in CRM (A) 4319 of 2022, we grant anticipatory bail the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner nos.1,3 and 4 will report before the

Investigating Officer once a month till the conclusion of the investigation and petitioner no.2 will cooperate with the investigation till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default, the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 3893 of 2022 is disposed of.
