The petitioner by filing the present application
under Article 227 of the Constitution of India have
prayed for expeditious disposal of the Matrimonial Suit
No. 78 of 2016, pending before the learned Additional
District Judge, 15th Court, Alipore.

The learned advocate for the petitioner submits
