The grievance raised in this public interest petition is that about 20 decimal of land in RS Dag No.4142, RS Khatian No.715, JL No.45 under police station – Chanditala, District – Hooghly recorded as ‘Kabarasthan’ as per record of rights but the private respondents have illegally encroached it and are raising the construction thereon by using miscreants.

The record reflects that the petitioner had already submitted the representation dated 20.07.2022 to respondent No.3, Block Development Officer-II, Hooghly BDO Office and the said representation is still pending.

Learned counsel for the State has fairly submitted that there is no objection in deciding the representation.

Hence, we dispose of the present petition by directing respondent No.3 to duly consider and decide the petitioner’s representation by giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and all concerned affected parties as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a

period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
