Heard Mr. Debabrata Saha Roy, learned counsel appearing for the appellant and Mr. Sushovan Sengupta, learned counsel for the State.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appeal has become infructuous in the meantime.

Mr. Sengupta, learned counsel for the State submits that the appeal has not become infructuous, in fact, the appellant having been fined Rs.4 lakh (Rupees four lakh) by competent authority of the State has deposited the fine. On deposit of the fine, he has been allowed to run the dealership.
