Mr. Angshuman Chakraborty, learned advocate appearing for the petitioners has informed the Court that he has instructions not to further pursue the present revisional application.

Petitioners are further granted liberty to inform any factual or documentary evidence which may be available with them to the Investigating Officer of the case.

With the aforesaid observations, CRR 2540 of 2021 is disposed of.
