By this intra-court appeal the respondent in the writ petition (State Bank of India) has challenged the order of the learned Single Judge dated 10th August, 2022 whereby WPA 18083 of 2022 has been disposed of by granting limited interim relief and directing the Bank not to take any further steps in pursuance to the Sale Notice until the DRT-II resumes its function or the matter is assigned to any other Bench of the DRT.

Limited submission of learned counsel for the appellants is that a direction be issued to the DRT-II/the assigned DRT to take up the matter expeditiously.

Hence, without interfering with the order of learned Single Judge, this appeal is disposed of by directing that DRT-II/the DRT which is assigned the matter, on being functional, will make an endeavour to decide the SA 282 of 2022 along with applications filed therein expeditiously.
