Report is submitted by Inspector-in-Charge, Chinsurah P. S. through the learned advocate for the State.

The passport has been deposited with the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hooghly at Chinsurah as a condition of bail granted by the learned Sessions Judge. The learned C. J. M., Hooghly will release the passport for a period of three months starting from 1st October, 2022.
