The facts involved in this writ petition are not disputed by the parties appearing before this Court. The petitioner is a nursing institution for General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) course.

The petitioner has obtained the **‘Essentiality Certificate’** from the Director of Health Services, West Bengal, **Annexure –P1** to the writ petition, dated July 26, 2022 and the **‘Provisional Permission for Nursing Training Institution’** from the West Bengal Nursing Council dated August 17, 2022, **Annexure–P2** to the writ petition. The petitioner had also applied for **First Inspection** before the Indian Nursing Council.

The parties appearing before this Court have confirmed that the issues involved in this writ petition is already covered by a **Judgment and Order dated August 26, 2022 passed by a coordinate Bench in WPA 19046 of 2022** along with a cluster of other writ petitions. The parties have further confirmed that the said **Judgment and Order dated August 26, 2022** bind them.

In view of the above, this writ petition **WPA 19854 of 2022** stands disposed of in the light of the said **Judgment and Order dated August 26, 2022** mentioned above including the directions made therein.

This order shall not preclude the Indian Nursing Council to take steps in accordance with law.
