In re : An Application for Anticipatory Bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Mollarpur Police Station Case No. 138 of 2022 dated 23.06.2022 under Sections 498A/304B/306/34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Leave granted to the learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners to correct the cause title.

Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

The police filed charge-sheet inter alia under Section 304B/306 of the Indian Penal Code after conducting an investigation inter alia under Section 304B/302 of the Indian Penal Code. The husband of the victim was enlarged on bail by the jurisdictional Court.

In such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in

Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

CRM (A) 4235 of 2022 is disposed of.
