In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Tapan** Police Station Case No.**270 of 2022** dated **12/05/2022** under Sections **420/406/34** of the Indian Penal Code (corresponding to G.R. Case No.953 of 2022).

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were falsely implicated.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the materials in the case diary.

The materials in the case diary suggest that the petitioners are involved in cheating as alleged. Requirement of custodial interrogation of the petitioners cannot be overlooked.

In such circumstances, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is rejected.

C.R.M. (A) 4272 of 2022 is dismissed.
