Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner took money for the purpose of mutation and did not do the work and, therefore, the present police complaint.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the statement recorded under Section 161 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Apparently, the petitioner is accused of making over forged documents relating to mutation.

In such circumstances, the requirement of custodial interrogation of the petitioner cannot be overlooked at this stage.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is rejected.

C.R.M. (A) 4305 of 2022 is dismissed.
