In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Chapra** Police Station Case No. **290 of 2021** dated **19.07.2021** under Sections **498A/304B** of the Indian Penal Code which corresponds to S. L. No. **2196 of 2021**.

Petitioner seeks bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the police filed charge sheet and that the petitioner is in custody for 168 days.

Learned advocate appearing for the State submits that the death was within two years of the marriage.

Considering the fact that the police filed charge sheet and considering the period of detention of the petitioner, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nadia, Krishnagar subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further

orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event, the petitioner fails to appear before the trial court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel the bail of the petitioner in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail is **allowed**.

CRM 8920 of 2021 is **disposed of**.
