Ms. Mousumi Chatterjee, learned advocate appears  
for the petitioner.

The petitioner by filing the present application  
under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has  
prayed for expeditious disposal of the Title Suit No. 148  
of 2013, pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior  
Division), Basirhat, North 24 Parganas.

The learned advocate for the petitioner submits  
that the learned Court below has been granting  
unnecessary adjournments and due to which, there is  
a delay in disposing of the case and such delay is  
causing hardship to the petitioner.

Having regard to the nature of relief claimed by the  
petitioner, being a prayer for expeditious disposal of the  
Title Suit No. 148 of 2013, I do not find any need to  
serve notice of the present application on the opposite  
parties and it is not likely to cause any prejudice to the  
interest of the opposite parties. Therefore, service of  
notice upon the opposite parties is dispensed with.

The learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Basirhat, North 24 Parganas is requested to dispose of the Title Suit No. 148 of 2013, as expeditiously as possible and in any event, within a period of six months from the date of communication of this order, without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.

Accordingly, the revisional application being **C.O. 2339 of 2021** is disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
