Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits he is in custody for 181 days. It is further submitted there was a relationship between the petitioner and the victim girl. He prays for bail.

Learned Counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits victim is a minor and was ravished. She had become pregnant.

We have considered the materials on record. Statement of the victim shows that victim was forcibly ravished by the petitioner. She is a minor.

Under such circumstances, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

The application for bail is, thus, rejected.
