Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits he is in custody for 67 days. It is also submitted that there is no way to sell adulterated country liquor.

Learned Counsel appearing for the State opposes prayer for bail.

Having considered materials on record prima facie disclosing involvement of the petitioner in selling illicit country liquor which cause death of number of persons.

Under such circumstance and in view of gravity of the offence, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

The application for bail is, thus, rejected.
