Heard learned advocates for the parties.

We have considered the materials on record. Explosive substances have already been recovered. Custodial interrogation for the progress of investigation is not necessary.

Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of ₹10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall meet the Investigating Officer once in a week until further orders.

Petitioner shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
