It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that she is the mother of co-accused Sumit Naskar who was in love with the deceased. Deceased committed suicide. She has been falsely implicated in the instant case.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

We have considered the materials on record. Though oral statements of one of the relations of the deceased show she had blamed the petitioner and others, no suicide note has been left behind by her.

In view of the aforesaid circumstance and the period of detention suffered by the petitioner, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM, Ranaghat, Nadia on condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

. In the event she fails to appear before the trial court without justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel her bail automatically without reference to this court.

The application being CRM (DB) 3939 of 2022 is disposed of.
