In view of the nature of order proposed to be made in this case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary.

Service upon the opposite parties stands dispensed with.

Accordingly, learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 1st Court, at Chinsurah, Hooghly, in Misc. Case No.21 of 2022, arising out of Title Execution Case No.9 of 2021, is requested ensure expeditious disposal of the Misc. Case, providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to either of the parties to this case in accordance with

law, but without granting any unnecessary adjournment, unless it is extremely unavoidable

The logical conclusion of the Misc. Case may be reached preferably within shortest possible time.

With this observation/direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.
