Affidavit-of-service filed by the learned advocate
for the petitioner be kept with the record.

The husband of the petitioner was an approved
Non-Teaching Staff (Group – D) of a secondary school
and died-in-harness on July 13, 2015.

The Pension Payment Order of the employee
concerned was issued on March 10, 2016 in
pursuance whereof the petitioner received the
gratuity and the arrear family Pension on May 18,
2016.

In the instant writ petition the prayer of the
petitioner is a writ of mandamus be issued
commanding the respondents to pay interest on the
said amount of gratuity and the arrear family
pension for the delayed payment.

Learned advocate for the State-respondents
does not oppose the prayer of the petitioner.

It is now well settled that the petitioner is
entitled to the interest, as prayed for.

The respondents, the concerned Treasury
Officer in particular are, therefore, directed to pay

interest @ 8% per annum on the gratuity and the arrear amount of family pension from the date of death of the employee concerned till the date of such payment.

The payment as aforesaid shall be made within the period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order, in default the said arrear amount shall fetch an additional interest of 2% per annum.

W.P.A. 24646 of 2022 stands disposed of with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
