In re : An Application for **Anticipatory Bail** under Section **438** of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Karandighi** Police Station Case No. **23** of **2021** dated **19.01.2021** under Sections **498A/304B/302/34** of the Indian Penal Code read with u/s **3/4** of the Dowry Prohibition Act.(Corresponding to G.R. case no. **183 of 2021**) and now charge sheet submitted being charge sheet no. 529 of 2021 dated 31.10.2021 under sections **498A/306/34** of the IPC read with u/s **3/4** of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The husband was enlarged on bail by the jurisdictional Court.

The police filed charge sheet.

The allegations as against the petitioners are omnibus in nature.

In such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under

Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is **allowed**.

CRM (A) 5324 of 2022 is disposed of.
