In re: I.A. CAN 2 of 2022

This application has been taken out by the petitioner for deleting the name of the opposite party no.2 from the array of the respondents. Since the petitioner does not wish to proceed against the opposite party no.2, the name of the opposite party no.2 stands deleted from the cause title of the revision petition.
