**CRM (A) 5381 of 2022**

In re : An Application for Anticipatory Bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Suti Police Station Case No. 255 of 2022 dated 10.05.2022 under Sections 325/326/307/354/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Apparently, none of the injured suffered grievous hurt. Admittedly, there was a free fight between the private parties. Some of the co-accused are on anticipatory bail granted by the jurisdictional Court.

In such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners will report to the Investigating Officer once in a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

CRM (A) 5381 of 2022 is disposed of.
