being Case No.12 of 2021 before the learned Tribunal
Court, at Barrackpore, North 24 Parganas, is the
ultimate relief sought for in this case.

No other point is raised requiring address by this
Court.

In view of the nature of order proposed to be made
in this case, no prior notice is considered to be
necessary.

Service upon the opposite parties stands dispensed
with.

Accordingly, learned Tribunal Court, at
Barrackpore, North 24 Parganas, in Case No.12 of
2021 is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of the
above referred case, subject to the suitability and
convenience of the court below, providing sufficient

opportunity of hearing to either of the parties to this case, but without granting any unnecessary adjournment, unless it is extremely unavoidable, preferably before end of August, 2023.

With this observation/direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.

Petitioner is directed to make communication of this order to the learned tribunal court as well as to the opposite parties and their learned advocate in the tribunal court.
