A direction to secure expeditious disposal of an injunction application filed in connection with a suit instituted in the year 2011, is the ultimate relief sought for in this case.

No other point is raised requiring address by this Court.

In view of the nature of order proposed to be made in this case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary.

Service upon the opposite parties stands dispensed with.

Accordingly, learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 7th Court, at Alipore, South 24 Parganas, in Title Suit No.14853 of 2011, is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of the injunction application, subject to the suitability and convenience of the court below, providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to either of the parties to this case, but without granting any

unnecessary adjournment, unless it is extremely unavoidable, preferably before the end of March, 2023.

With this observation/direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.

Petitioner is directed to make communication of this order to the learned court below as well as to the opposite parties and their learned advocate in the court below
