In re : An Application for **Anticipatory Bail** under Section **438** of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with G.R. no. **45 of 2022** arising out of **Swarupnagar** Police Station Case No. **09** of **2022** dated **05.01.2022** under Sections **306/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Apparently, the victim committed suicide.

Other co-accuseds were enlarged on anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the State submits that the petitioner is the principal accused.

Apparently, there was a relationship between the petitioner and the victim, committing suicide.

The materials in the case diary, at this stage, do not disclose any overact on the part of the petitioner.

Consequently, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further

condition that the petitioner shall report before the Investigating Officer once in a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

CRM (A) 5576 of 2022 is disposed of.
