This is an application under Section 401 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed by the petitioner challenging an order dated 8th September, 2010 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Purulia, thereby setting aside the order dated 28th July, 2010 passed by the learned Executive Magistrate at Purulia in connection with Misc. Case No. 35 of 2009 under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
