Police seized some particles claiming to contain explosive substance.

There is a statement recorded under Section 161 of the Criminal Procedure Code of an eye-witness claiming that the petitioners were involved in the incident of hurling bombs.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners therein, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is **rejected**.

CRM (A) 5651 of 2022 is dismissed.
