Petitioner is in custody for 89 days. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he has been falsely implicated in the instant case. There is no direct evidence connecting him with the murder.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

We have considered the materials on record. Statements of witnesses show petitioner and others were last seen with the victim. They were also seen leaving the spot hurriedly after the occurrence. Weapon of offence has also been recovered from the petitioner.

Under such circumstances, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected.
