Petitioner is in custody for 221 days. He renews his prayer for bail.

Learned Advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

We have considered the materials on record. Keeping in mind the facts and circumstances of the case and as co-accuseds have been enlarged on bail, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., Sanjoy Mondol @ Sanjay Mondal @ Sanjoy Kumar Mondal shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tamluk, Purba Medinipur subject to condition he shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall

not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the Trial Court without any justifiable cause, the trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The application for bail is, thus, disposed of.
