**CRM (A) 5895 of 2022**

In re : An Application for Anticipatory Bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Nakashipara Police Station Case No. 857 of 2022 dated 05.11.2022 under Sections 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

There are statements recorded under Section 161 of the Code of Criminal Procedure stating that both the petitioners were involved in torturing the victim and abetting the victim in committing suicide.

The second petitioner was arrested. Therefore, CRM (A) 5895 of 2022 is dismissed as infructuous so far as the second petitioner (Tapas Kumanr Nag @ Tapas Nag) is concerned.

So far as the first petitioner is concerned, considering the statement recorded under Section 161 of the Code of Criminal Procedure implicating the first petition in the incident, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the first petitioner (Subrata Nag).

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the first petitioner (Subrata Nag) is rejected.

CRM (A) 5895 of 2022 is disposed of.
