In this matter, petitioner has challenged the impugned summon dated 27th October, 2017 issued by the respondent authorities concerned by which petitioner was directed to appear on 6th November, 2017, in my view, the impugned summon has lost its force today and against the issuance of impugned summon, cause of action does not survive at present.
