Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail on the ground of parity.

Petitioner stands on the same footing as that of the other co-accused who were enlarged on anticipatory bail by the order dated October 31, 2022 passed in CRM (A) 4794 of 2022.

In such circumstances, we extend the same facility to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner will report before the Investigating Officer as and when called for till the conclusion of the investigation and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.
CRM (A) 5925 of 2022 is disposed of.
