Mr. Sajal Kanti Bhattacharya, learned advocate appears on behalf of the writ petitioner/applicant and submits that during pendency of the writ petition one notice dated 2nd September, 2021 was issued by the concerned Panchayat Authorities for settling water bodies in favour of some individuals.

Ms. Susmita Saha Dutta, learned advocate appears on behalf of the respondent no. 5 and submits that upon following the procedure pursuant

to the tender notice dated 2nd September, 2021 water bodies have been settled in favour of some individuals.
