Mr. Debasish Mukherjee, learned advocate appears for the petitioner.

The learned advocate for the petitioner files affidavit of service along postal receipt and track report. The track report shows that service could not be effected for want of insufficient address.

Be that as it may, the petitioner by filing the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has prayed for expeditious disposal of the Title Appeal No. 9 of 2015, pending before the learned Additional District Judge, 1<sup>st</sup> Court, Cooch Behar.

The learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the learned Court below has been granting unnecessary adjournments and due to which, there is a delay in disposal of the case and such delay is causing hardship to the petitioner.

Having regard to the nature of relief claimed by the petitioner, being a prayer for expeditious disposal of the title appeal, it is not likely to cause any prejudice to the interest of the opposite parties.

The learned Additional District Judge, 1<sup>st</sup> Court, Cooch Behar, is requested to dispose of the Title Appeal No. 9 of 2015, as expeditiously as possible and in any event, within a period of three months from the date of communication of this order, without granting any adjournment whatsoever to any of the parties.

Accordingly, the revisional application being **C.O. 02 of 2022** is disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
