In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Maynaguri** P.S. Case No. **527 of 2021** dated **29/10/2021** under Sections **498A/302/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Considering the fact that the husband of the deceased was granted bail by the jurisdictional Court and considering the suicide note of the victim, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners will cooperate with the investigation and shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is

allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 93 of 2022 is disposed of.
