THE COURT: The contemnor no.2 has filed an affidavit, affirmed on 9th June, 2022. The reason given for not showing cause earlier is satisfactory. The affidavit is accepted and taken on record.

The contempt application accordingly stands disposed of. The rule stands discharged. Any other claim that the petitioner may have against the Bank may be agitated in accordance with law. There will be no order as to costs.
