1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. There is no appearance on behalf of the petitioner when the matter is called.
3. Mr. P.K. Mohanty, learned counsel appeared for the Opposite Party-Orissa Khadi Village Industries Board on behalf of Mr. B. Dash.
4. Learned counsel Mr. P.K.
