Mr. Mohanty, learned advocate appears on behalf of petitioner and submits, his client has made application (I.A. no.11492 of 2022) saying that office of Sarpanch issued letter dated 6th August, 2022, wherein it was stated, inter alia, it had been unanimously decided to allot five numbers of shop rooms to petitioners but, same could not be done by reason of pendency of the writ petition.
