03. **1.** This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
- 2.** The petitioner, a Proprietorship firm had availed a term loan as well as a cash credit account facility from the opposite parties-Bank for the purpose of his business. Due to financial indiscipline the loan account was classified as Non-performing Assets (NPA) on 31.08.2019 and subsequently possession notice was issued under Section 13 (4) of the SARFAESI Act on 03.03.2021 and the auction sale was fixed for 07.01.2022.
- 3.** Learned counsel for the petitioner files a Memo dated 10.02.2022 seeking liberty to withdraw the writ petition to pursue the remedy as available under law. Memo is taken on record.
- 4.** The writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
