1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State.
3. The petitioner is in custody since 26.10.2021 in connection with Chamakhandi P.S. Case No. 173 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 814 of 2021 pending in the court of learned S.D.J.M., Chatrapur for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 454/379/427/34 of IPC.
4. Having regard to the submissions made, the materials on record, the period of detention already undergone and the fact that the charge sheet has already been submitted coupled with the fact that the petitioner appears to have been implicated in the case on the basis of the statement of the co-accused persons, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail. Let the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as the court in seisin over the matter may deem fit and proper to impose including the condition that out

of two sureties to be furnished by the petitioner for such amount as may be fixed by the trial court, one should belong to the district of Ganjam.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned counsel for the parties may utilize a printout of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587, dated 25th March, 2020, modified by Notice No.4798, dated 15th April, 2021, and Court's Office Order circulated vide Memo Nos. 514 and 515 dated 7th January, 2022.
