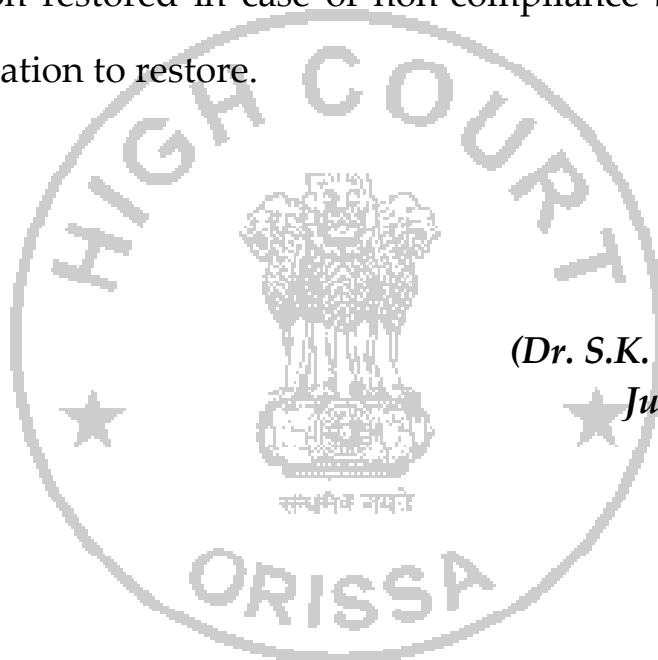
ORDER

01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement.
2. Heard.
3. This CONTC has been filed by the Petitioner for non-compliance of the order dated 01.03.2021 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No. 766 of 2021 by the Contemnor.
4. In such view of the matter, the Contemnor is directed to comply the order dated 01.03.2021 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No. 766 of 2021 within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order and communicate the result thereof to the Petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter. The Petitioner shall file a copy of this order along with a self-addressed envelope

with sufficient postage stamp before the Contemnor within a period of fifteen days hence.

5. Needless to say that if the Contemnor fails to do as directed above, he/ she shall be personally present in Court.

6. Accordingly, this CONTC is disposed of being dropped. However, the petitioner is at liberty to get this petition restored in case of non-compliance by filing an application to restore.
