2. This application under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. has been filed by the Petitioner with a prayer to quash the order dated 11th June, 2010 passed by the learned J.M.F.C., Banpur in I.C.C. No.50 of 2010, taking cognizance of the offences under Sections 341, 352, 506 read with Section 34 of the I.P.C.
3. Heard.

5. After going through the statement of the witnesses as well as other materials available on record, this Court is not inclined to entertain the prayer made in this petition.
