“7th July, 2022: 1. None appears in this appeal. The record bears names of eight learned advocates empowered on behalf of appellant. 2. In event none appears to press the appeal on adjourned date or thereafter, the appeal is likely to be dismissed. 3. List on 14th July, 2022.

14th July, 2022: 1. None appears. 2. The list reflects names of several learned advocates engaged by appellant. That is good notice.
