2. The Petitioner in this writ petition prays for a direction to set aside the order dated 19th December, 2018 passed by the Additional Tahasildar, Jatni-Opposite party No.3 in Mutation Case No.5909 of 2018.
3. In course of hearing, Mr. Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner has a remedy under Rule 42 of the Orissa Survey & Settlement Rules, 1962 to assail the order impugned herein. Hence, he prays for withdrawal of the writ petition to avail statutory remedy.
