02. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with Chandipur P.S. Case No. 92 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No.971 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned S.D.J.M., Balasore for the commission of alleged offences punishable alleged offences under sections 272/273/34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 51(a) of Odisha Excise Act.

Perused the F.I.R. annexed to the anticipatory bail application.

Learned counsel for the State on instruction submitted that the petitioner is having criminal antecedents.

In view of the materials available on record and availability of criminal antecedents and the nature of accusation against the petitioner, while not inclining to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, liberty is granted to him to surrender and move for bail in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today in the event of which the learned Courts below shall dispose of the same in accordance with law expeditiously. The case records shall be made available to the Courts concerned for disposal of the bail application.
