1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. Perused the recitals in the I.A. and on consideration of the submissions of the learned counsel for the parties, paragraph No.6 of the Order dtd. 17.05.2022 be substituted by the following;

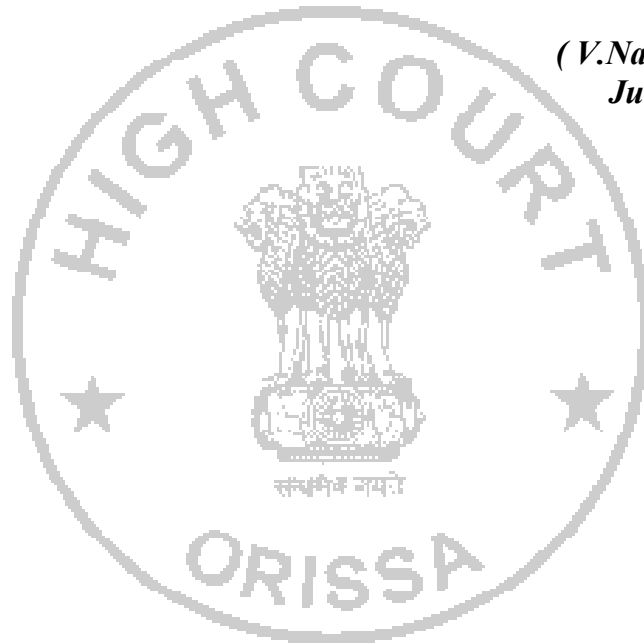
is called upon to make the necessary deposit within the stipulated period.
