01. 1. This matter is taken up by Video Conferencing Mode.
2. The Petitioner being in custody in connection with Dhenkanal Town P.S. Case No.245 of 2018 corresponding to C.T. (Sessions) No.70 of 2019 on the file of learned Sessions Judge, Dhenkanal for alleged commission of offence under Section-302/328/120-B/34 of the IPC, has filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for his release on bail in the above mentioned case.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
4. Considering the submissions made and on going through the materials on record as placed, while being not grant of bail to the Petitioner, this application stands disposed of with the observation that the trial court would do well to take all such effective steps as provided in law for conclusion of the

trial as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of two months hence in accordance with law.

It is made clear that in the event the trial is not completed within the above period, it would be open for the Petitioner to renew his prayer for grant of bail.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

6. As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned Counsel for the parties may utilize a printout of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned Advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587 dated 25th March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798 dated 15th April, 2021 and Court's Office order circulated vide Memo Nos.514 and 515 dated 7th January, 2022.
