1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).

The petitioner by way of this application U/S. 482 of Cr.P.C seeks to quash the order taking cognizance dated 05.11.2015 passed by learned Special Judge(Vigilance), Sambalpur in C.T.R No. 40 of 2015 but no stay has been granted from proceeding further in this case and in the meantime, seven years have already elapsed from passing of the impugned order.
