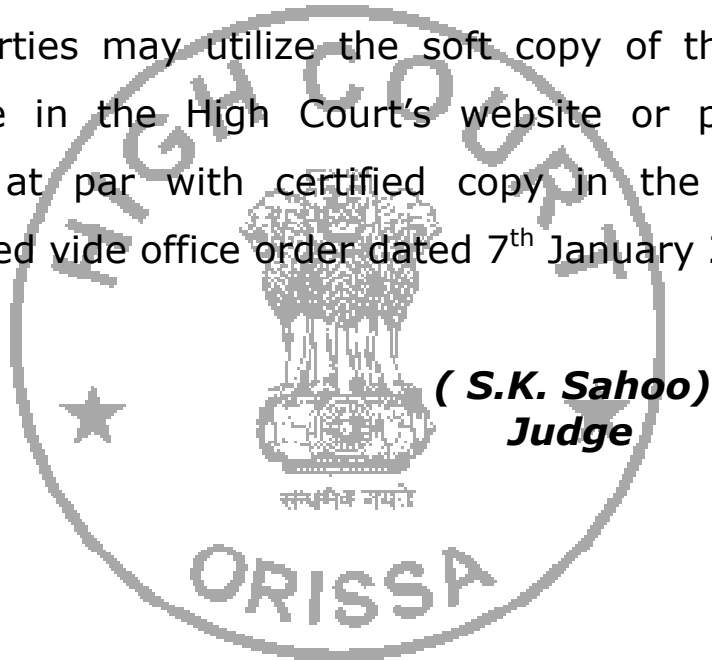
Perused the F.I.R. annexed to the anticipatory
